WHEREAS:

1. By Certificate of Referral dated 19th February, 2021 the Minister referred the subject Trade Dispute to the Industrial Tribunal; and
2. The Applicants filed in the Industrial Tribunal an Originating Application (Form A) on the 7th April, 2021. The Respondent did not file a Defence in the matter and has never made an appearance; and
3. Pursuant to **Rule 15 (1)** of the **Industrial Relations (Tribunal Procedure) Rules 2010**, the matter was fixed for Case Management Hearings and Trials on multiple occasions; and
4. A Final Adjournment was given on 6th June, 2023 and an Unless Order was subsequently issued on 15th November, 2023, for the filing of the Applicants' Bundle of Documents, to include all of their supporting evidence, on or before 15th December, 2023; and
5. On 11th December, 2025 the matter was once again fixed for Trial. There was no appearance by or on behalf of the Applicants nor the Respondent; and
6. Having confirmed that the Applicants' Counsel was served notice of this Hearing on 12th November, 2025, and upon the Applicants' failure to appear and to comply with the Order on Directions issued on 15th November, 2023;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

In light of the above, the Originating Application filed by the Applicants on 7th April, 2021, is struck out and the matter stands dismissed for non-compliance with the Unless Order, and for want of prosecution, pursuant to **Rules 17(1)** and **21(1)(f)** of the **Industrial Relations Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 2025**.
