WHEREAS:

1. By Certificate of Referral dated the 1st October, 2024 the Minister referred the Trade Dispute to the Industrial Tribunal; and

3. The Respondent filed in the Industrial Tribunal a Notice of Appearance (Form D) on the 6th December, 2024 and its Defence (Form E) on the 15th April 2025; and
4. Pursuant to Rule 15(1) of the Industrial Relations (Tribunal Procedure) Rules, 2010 the Industrial Tribunal set a fixture on the 10th November, 2025 for Case Management Hearing.
